About the hosting agency

Child Protection Centers and Services (CPCS) was founded in 2002 to answer the children's needs in the streets of Nepal. Every year, hundreds of kids, hundreds of kids, attracted by the allure of the "big city", leave their villages. Once there, they discover the harsh realities of life in the streets and are left on their own to face multiple forms of danger and abuse (moral, sexual and physical).

CPCS was created to support these children and youth and to prevent more children from ending up in the streets.

The organization's work can be divided into three steps: prevention, risk reduction and social rehabilitation.

Volunteer Profile

Responsibilities and tasks

- ❖ To help the children during classes and with their homework
- ❖ To help in the kitchen or with domestic chores
- ❖ To organize cultural, artistic or sports activities
- ❖ If necessary, to help with administrative tasks (translations...)

Candidate Profile

- ❖ Being 18 years old.
- ❖ Dynamic, creative, and proven skills of animation with children
- ❖ Strong experience in providing recreational activities to children (drama, play, games, circus, sport, storytelling, drawing/painting, artistic activities, music)
- ❖ Being autonomous and independent. This is an important condition to be able to work in the existing structure. The volunteer must not be a burden to the

team. He/she has to manage his daily routine and transportation himself, and be able to deal with the difficulties that come with distant travels (cultural, social, medical, practical).

- ❖ Being prepared and informed about the country, reading the documents about the project and undertaking steps to raise funds (as a participation to the project and its centers and departments).
- ❖ Being insured by an insurance company that covers medical repatriation, and support costs (even in case of conflicts/earthquakes in the country or the need of an helicopter evacuation).
- ❖ Coming to Nepal with an active, respectful and social attitude.

CPCS offers

- ❖ For a contribution of 15 Euro / day, CPCS offers:
 - Airport pick up
 - Transport to the locations (Sindhuli and/or Dolakha, in the beginning and end of the volunteer period – not during weekends or small holidays)
 - Accommodation
 - Cleaning of the room and common facilities (two times a week)
 - Clean sheets (once a week)
 - All local meals in the centers
 - Safe drinking water
 - Cold and (sometimes) hot water (facilities in Dolakha - more basic in Sindhuli (but family-like)
 - Continuous follow up by an English speaking staff (Rajendra Rokka - Coordinator)
 - First 2-3 days are spent in Kathmandu in a local guest house (tourist area) - meals not included!
- ❖ Enthusiastic and motivated cohesive team.
- ❖ Responsibility, autonomy, room for initiative.

Application Process

Only short-listed candidates will be contacted for an interview.
